1. **ASI Appointment:** According to the union folks at Victor, they are upset about losing Angela Perrotto to Pittsford.
2. **Legislative Breakfast March 7:** We need a few more people to attend.
3. **Health Fund Grievance Resolution:** The District has extended the deadline for getting Health Fund credit for people on leave after October 1, but back by February 1. It will be in *Speak Out* again this month. Contact B. Shapiro for the form.
4. **Superintendent Conference Day, March 20:** Plans are all set.
5. **Retirement Party:** The District agreed to honor at the 20-year level. Building Reps will confirm names that fall in the 20-25 years of service in Pittsford.

It is easier to prevent an error than to correct one. Reminder that all regular sub jobs must be posted. Anyone working as a regular sub may apply, but only after the internal postings.
