Election Process

There are eight (8) positions on the PDTA Representative Assembly that are up for election this year. (1 SRP Representative and 7 Assistant Representatives)
Applications for these positions are available through your building PDTA rep or by calling or emailing Karen – x1117. The positions are for two year terms based on the SRP Constitution. All applications are due in the PDTA Office on Marsh Road by Friday, April 27th.

Job Openings

Please watch the district website and the hard copies posted in your buildings for the latest SRP open positions. Respond to postings promptly.
CSE positions – the principal of each building determines the CSE needs of the building. If there is no need, you should respond to the postings for CSE positions in other buildings.
FYI – positions do become available at the end of the summer when final student placements are made.

SRP Advisor/Advisee Program

Four (4) buildings are in need of SRP Advisors for next year – Thornell Rd. Allen Creek, Barker Road, and Calkins Road.

There is a stipend for SRP Advisors – 1-3 advisees = \$250.00 per year
4+ advisees = \$500.00 per year

The SRP Advisors are available in each building to welcome new SRP employees, assist new SRP employees with building procedures and district policy, and general orientation. Advisors need to have three years of experience in the district.

The Teachers' Center has applications for SRP Advisors on-line. Applications are due by May 30th.
