

**MINUTES SRP GENERAL MEETING  
MAY 6, 2010**

1. Spring **Vote Cope campaign** is underway. Please check your buildings as to times and remember to contribute generously to this important political action fund. Your support is needed more than ever in this difficult political climate.
2. **PDTA shirts** are currently for sale in your buildings for \$18.00. Please be sure to support this PDTA fundraiser which supports local non-profits.
3. **School Budget and School Board Vote** is coming up on May 18 in the BRMS gym. Surprisingly, many NYSUT members do not get out to vote in their Districts. It is very important that all NYSUT members who live in Pittsford make the effort to vote on May 18 and participate in the exit poll. It will make a tremendous difference.
4. The **District Retirement Party** will be held on May 27 at 6:00 p.m. at Mario's Italian Steakhouse on Monroe Ave. Several of our fellow SRPs will be honored this year. Please be sure to sign up to attend the party.
5. This year there will be an **election for Assistant SRP Rep** to replace Mary Hamblin who will be retiring. Candidates for the position are Barbara Manchee (SHS), Lisa Kenny-Daily (MHS) and Debral Migliore (CRMS). Voting will take place on May 19 in all buildings. Only SRPs are permitted to vote for this position.

8. **Job Postings** should be available for SRPs beginning May 15 according to our contract. If you are interested in a job transfer, please respond to any available postings in writing according to deadlines. Postings will continue through the summer, so be sure to keep watching.
9. Paras are reminded to submit a **Para Summer Day/Professional Learning Prior Approval Verification Form** with their Principal's signature by the end of the school year. Paras are required to work one day during the summer or participate in 6 hours of professional development through the Teacher Center with Principal's approval.
10. Discussion took place regarding pay for after-school work with special ed students. Teachers were to be paid at a higher rate than SRP's. If it is chaperone rate it should be the same for teachers and SRPs. Union is looking into the issue.
