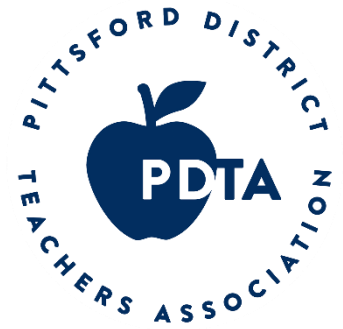


Executive Committee Meeting Monday November 2, 2020



Updates:

- SLB Update:
 - New member days are 65
 - Donations are 113
 - FFCRA:

Dwayne is working on MOA for family sick days that represents the language of FFCRA, which might apply for family sick time due to quarantine.

Discussions:

- PDTA/HR – Travel protocols for upcoming breaks
Communication forthcoming. Dwayne shared some details of the MOA, which corresponds with the FFCRA language. This MOA will be communicated to the membership by Dwayne.
- Sick Day Guidance and Substitute Process Document from PDTA
Communication came out for sick leave guidance
- Superintendent's Day:
Discussed conference days. Despite PDTA advocacy there are still concerns about communication of the conference day. Executive committee shared those concerns with Dwayne who will bring them to the superintendent.
- PDTA Apparel Preview
 - Stephanie presented the new proposed apparel sale to the EC
 - Proposed sale will be approved at RA next week
- SRP Recognition Day 17th of November
 - RA agreed that staff members from BOCES who support our students in a similar way to an SRP will also receive a gift from PDTA. Car magnets can only go to NYSUT members as they were donated by NYSUT.
- PDTA meetings:
 - All meetings will be moving to fully remote for the time being
 - Decision made to prevent pulling multiple people from different buildings together into one space.
 - PDTA wants to remind members of the importance of staying distant with masks on. Masking and distance is why we are still opened right now. At least 2 buildings would be closed if we hadn't made those choices.
- Scenario Committee Update:
We received an update from scenario committee about devices and roles if we pivot to fully remote.

- b. Readiness to pivot to fully remote. Shared document (process)
Getting technology to students: discussed using different staff to image devices to make this process quicker.
- c. Preparedness for the changes that may result from Remote/In-Person Choice for second semester.
- d. The need for platform training and access for paraprofessionals.
- e. The need to define expectations for non-instructional roles. What will their job be if we go fully remote? Person needs to be ready to serve as a sub, reading support etc.
Some certificated staff members have been told that they will move to their certification area if we go fully remote.
