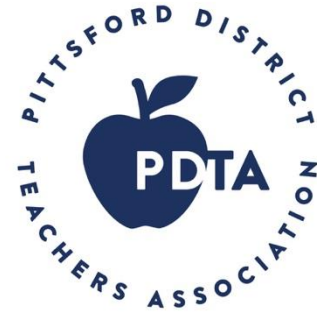


# PDTA SRP Representative
