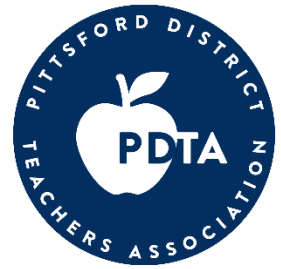

- 2020-21 Posting Process:

- PDTA Day of Giving:  
Targeted to PEF for direct student and family needs. Friday June 4, 2020.
- Ongoing Re-Opening Discussion
  - PDTA continues to work with the district on scenarios for re-opening to full 5 day per week instruction.
  - PDTA is advocating for federal funds to be used to help support SEL and instructional needs in the district.
- Preparations for 2021-22
  - PDTA and NYSUT Advocacy efforts
    - a) Remote
      - NYSUT is advocating that remote will not be mandate. If need exists, it should be monitored by BOCES.
    - b) Hybrid Instruction
      - NYSUT and PDTA continue to oppose simultaneous virtual and in-person learning.
    - c) Vaccinations
      - PDTA is opposed to mandated vaccination.
- NYS Early Retirement Incentive Legislation
  - This legislation was not included in state budget, however NYSUT continues to advocate for the interest.
