

Governance of the Pittsford District Teachers' Association

The Pittsford District Teachers Association (PDTA) is governed by its Representative Assembly (R.A.). The R.A. consists of District-wide positions and unit positions.

ANY MEMBER of PDTA can fill the District PDTA positions. If there are two or more candidates, an election is held. All PDTA members would vote in that election.

In addition there are two non-voting members:

The remaining members of the Representative Assembly are the unit positions consisting of the Building Representatives, Assistant Building Representatives, SRP Representative, and SRP Assistant Representatives.

Each of the nine buildings is entitled to a Building Representative. All PDTA members in the building elect this representative. If a building has more than 25 members, the building is entitled to an Assistant Building Representative for each additional 25 members. **Any PDTA member in the building may serve as a Building Representative or an Assistant Building Representative.**

School Related Professionals (SRP) members are considered a tenth unit. Members of this group are, in essence, counted twice; once as members of their respective buildings and again as members of this special unit. Only members of this special unit may serve as SRP Representative or SRP Assistant Representative.

The Executive Committee, the executive body of the PDTA, is a sub-committee of the Representative Assembly. Members of the Executive Committee are the officers, the nine Building Representatives, the SRP Representative and the Resolution Specialist.
