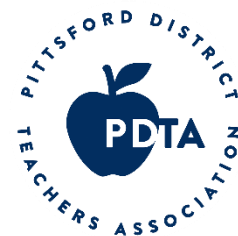

**Old Business:**

- **SRP responsibilities:** Meeting with Dwayne, Lorinda and Elizabeth Woods about SRP responsibilities during the shutdown. PDTA is currently working on a practice document for members to help.
- **Technology:** District is running short on readily accessible technology. The available computers are reserved for teachers and students. If students are waiting more than 48 hours for a device, please contact your building representative.
- **Building representatives** should be vigilant on how buildings are handling leaves during the shutdown.
- **Athletics / Extracurricular compensation:** PDTA continues to discuss this with the district.

**New Business:**

1. **Secondary essential Learning:**
  - Teachers have not been properly trained on what that means.
  - District is going to be asking teachers what is considered essential and teachers will be reporting that information to their Standards Leader.
2. **SAC / EAC**
  - Both SAC and EAC have met.
  - SAC reviewed plans for potential grading for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.
  - PDTA would like to run with the model of “Do no harm and do no over-gifting”
3. **PDTA member in communications office**
  - Member has resigned. PDTA would like that position to remain in our unit. Dwayne is currently discussing this with the district.
4. **PDTA electronic payment.**
  - Treasurer will set up a gmail account for potential electronic payments in the future.
5. **Maternity / Child care leaves**
  - members who were planning to take the rest of the year off, but have decided to work from home can change their leave with HR.

6. Elementary:

- Administration needs to remind members at the elementary level that there should not be live instruction.

7. Budget concerns:

- While there are budget concerns, we are not looking at any lay-offs or reductions.

8. District will be extending the 1-year pilots with some possible modifications according to feedback.
