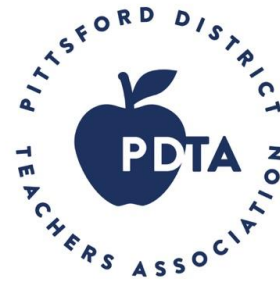


PDTA Membership Building Volunteer
