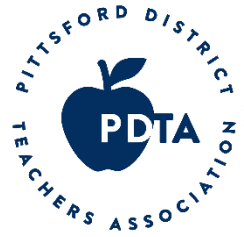

Old Business:

- All extra duty contracts should have been paid to members on May 28th. Each contract signed would be a separate line item on the pay stub. You can view this information in WinCap. New Business:

- District is aware that there is a non-violent BLM rally scheduled for next week. This event is to occur during the work day, and the district will not support staff members attending if their work responsibilities have not been met.
 - Please remember, staff members who attend are not representing the district. They should not wear any district attire nor should they wear their school ID badge.
- Professional Development opportunities are reserved for teachers due to the contractual requirement for teachers to complete 12 hours of PD. PDTA is looking into the possibility to include EAs in the event that there are open seats.
- School Reopening Scenario Steering Committee has been set. This small committee consists of 5 PDTA members along with members from the Central Office Team, and the Administrative Association. The PDTA members are: Dwayne Cerbone, Lynne Drake, Kristen Dolan, Lisa Mauger and Kim Chesko. This committee is currently looking at 5 different scenarios for re-entry in the fall along with 31 individual items within those scenarios. PDTA will be distributing to staff a data collection tool shortly to gather input about re-entry in the fall.

- Executive Committee was briefed on some PDTA budget proposals that will be brought to the Representatives Assembly. There are extra funds in the budget for next year, and Dwayne has proposed they be repurposed to increase representative stipends.
- District has agreed to honor retirement requests with full career awards to displaced SRPs who request by June 17th. SRPs must be 55 years old with 10 years of service.
