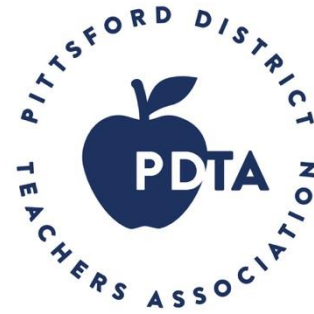


PDTA Vice-President for Negotiations
