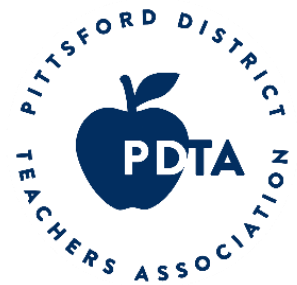


# **Executive Committee meeting June 11, 2020**



- Establishing training with technology for paras
  - Two hour training for all platforms
  - Training will concentrate on student view
  - Training can utilize the para summer workday, which would be no cost to the district.
  - Summer training would be optional, more will need to be offered in the fall
  - Any EA in a developmental program can participate with teacher in a workshop.

Authorization from principal is needed.
- Executive committee discussed ways to gather input from members to bring back to the scenario committee. Executive committee agreed that the input survey should contain a rating scale, as well as specific items.
- Summer building access: Building representatives should communicate with administration that members would be coming to them if they need access to the buildings. If Admin will not be at the building, there must be another point person for members to contact. Capacity must remain under 50%
- PDTA tee shirts have been delivered to buildings. PR representatives have put the tee shirts in one spot. Building committee PR representative should be communicating out where the tee shirts were placed. Building representative should follow up on this.
- Stipend checks have been sent to Karen. They will be mailed out.
- Budget results should be in by Wednesday AM
- Concern about masks during the ESY program. Masks are not being required for students, which could leave teachers at a higher risk. Teachers should be aware before they agree to work at this program. There may be eligibility for unemployment for any para who typically works at ESY but is unable to this summer.
