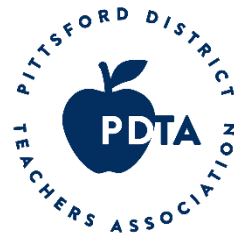


## Executive Committee meeting March 30, 2020

### **Old business:**

- Professional Development:
