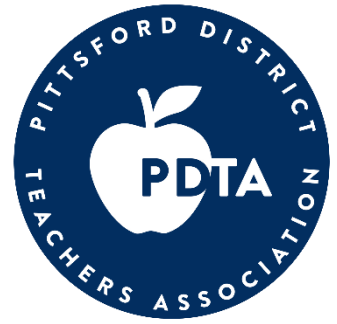


# Executive Committee Meeting Monday June 7, 2021 at 3:30 pm



## Updates:

- Review of NYSUT/PDPA Code of Conduct
- Treasurer
  - PDPA Budget Draft for 2021-22
    - Discussion on the proposed budget will continue on Teams. Budget advisory committee continues to work out some numbers and re-organization of our budget categories

## New Business:

- Retirement Party, 20-year Reception, Tenure Presentations: Review
  - Proposal: Opening day flowers for tenured members  
Newly tenured members did not receive a reception this past year. Proposal was made to give them a flower to wear to honor them on Opening day.
  - Invited Shelly Clement and Jolene DiBrango to opening day ceremony to talk to the membership
- 2020-21 Posting Process:
  - Postings will continue throughout the summer for Certificated and SRPs. Members are encouraged to monitor emails if interested or displaced.
- Secondary schedule  
Secondary schedule: PDPA has initiated conversations with members of the COT regarding considered WIN times at the secondary level. We have advocated for like scheduling in leveled buildings as well as the need to potentially negotiate the impact on some contractual provisions.
- Internal processes for teacher leader positions
  - PDPA is looking into a common practice for soliciting department representation on interview committees for department leaders. Building representatives will work with their building administration on a way to collect input from the department around leadership.
- PDPA Day of Giving
  - Date: Friday 6/18
  - Gift to PEF directed to funding of student/family financial needs ongoing through the pandemic.
- Re-opening 2021-22
  - PDPA continues to have discussions around state and county guidelines as they are released.
  - PDPA is going to continue to be involved in these discussions next year.
  - Opening day is not set yet. District is looking at options of some smaller groups in the event that we can't all gather together.
  - June 16<sup>th</sup> is the last Wednesday for working from home. If there is an issue, members should contact administration.
- Summer roles

- PDTA leaders do not work over the summer
- PDTA supports members right to elect into optional summer work. Dwayne will address this in his message to membership.
- Building heat
  - Currently the mask updates are that students are allowed extended mask breaks when seated at least 6 feet apart.
- 2020/21 PDTA Leader Reflections
  - Dwayne applied for a grant to establish a “Take a look at Teaching” club at each high school.

Building Reports:

- Elementary: Concern about section size. District is not opening sections that have gone over the planning numbers until July 31<sup>st</sup> due to concern about mandatory remote.
  - Need to hold to planning numbers on July 31<sup>st</sup>
  - District has committed to smaller class size; therefore 1-2 kids shouldn't be a question
  - Hiring after July yields a smaller teacher pool, especially for part time and specials.
